OUR CONFESSION AND OUR FATHER'S FORGIVENESS

P: Dear friends in Christ, our Savior, Jesus, tells us a story in Luke chapter 15 about a son who one day decides to "up and leave" his father and who goes as far away as his inheritance will take him and spends all his inheritance money on "foolish living." Finally, after a famine hits the country in which he lives and after he is forced to hire himself out to take care of pigs where he longs to eat what the pigs have to eat-just to survive, that young man comes to his senses and decides to go back to his father. He rehearses his speech, "Father, I've sinned against heaven and against you and am no longer worthy to be called your son-please, make me like one of your hired men." His father, however, did not want another servant-he simply wanted his "lost" son to be "found" and so, when the young man was still a long way off, he spotted him from a distance and raced out to him and threw his arms around him and received him back, as his son.

We can relate to that young man-for we too have walked away from our Father's will for us and have lived foolishly. We have had thoughts that are wicked and evil and are not appropriate for children of God; we have said words that dishonor our Father in heaven and give Him a bad name; we have done things with our hands and bodies that are not loving and thoughtful and have not lived like dear children should. Let us go to our Father now, and confess our sins to Him and ask Him for the sake of Jesus Christ-the innocent Son Who was punished in our place, to forgive us.

C: Father, I have sinned against heaven and against You. I am no longer worthy to be called your child. Please forgive me all my sins for the sake of Jesus Christ, my Savior.

P: Our Father in heaven did an amazing thing-he turned away from his one and only Son, Whom He loved, in order to receive back into "His good graces" we children who have been disobedient and rebellious. Our Father now welcomes us with open arms and forgives us all our sins. As the Apostle John pens, "How great the love the Father has lavished on us that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!!!" (I John 3:1) May God give us strength now to live as His redeemed, restored and forgiven children!!!

Almighty God and Savior, You have set the final day and hour when we shall be delivered from this world of sin and death. Keep us ever watchful for the coming of Your Son that we may sit with Him and all Your holy ones at the great marriage feast in heaven; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, Who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

WORD OF GOD

Daniel 12:1-3 "At that time Michael, the great prince who protects your people, will arise. There will be a time of distress such as has not happened from the beginning of nations until then. But at that time your people—everyone whose name is found written in the book—will be delivered. ² Multitudes who sleep in the dust of the earth will awake: some to everlasting life, others to shame and everlasting contempt. ³ Those who are wise will shine like the brightness of the heavens, and those who lead many to righteousness, like the stars for ever and ever.

Hebrews 10:11-18 ¹¹ Day after day every priest stands and performs his religious duties; again and again he offers the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. ¹² But when this priest had offered for all time one sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God, ¹³ and since that time he waits for his enemies to be made his footstool. ¹⁴ For by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy. ¹⁵ The Holy Spirit also testifies to us about this. First he says: ¹⁶ "This is the covenant I will make with them after that time, says the Lord. I will put my laws in their hearts, and I will write them on their minds." ¹⁷ Then he adds: "Their sins and lawless acts I will remember no more." ¹⁸ And where these have been forgiven, sacrifice for sin is no longer necessary.

John 5:25-29 ²⁵ Very truly I tell you, a time is coming and has now come when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God and those who hear will live. ²⁶ For as the Father has life in himself, so he has granted the Son also to have life in himself. ²⁷ And he has given him authority to judge because he is the Son of Man. ²⁸ "Do not be amazed at this, for a time is coming when all who are in their graves will hear his voice ²⁹ and come out—those who have done what is good will rise to live, and those who have done what is evil will rise to be condemned.
